

Imputed Righteousness Which is of the Law VERSES Imputed Righteousness Which is of Faith

Under the Old Testament, a **just** man was one who was **righteous** before the LORD. **Imputed righteousness** was based on **faithful obedience**.

Deut 6:24-25 And the <u>LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that he might preserve us alive, as it is at this day.</u> ²⁵ And <u>it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the LORD our God, as he hath commanded us.</u> SEE Lev 18:4-5 Rom 2:13 (For not the hearers of the law <i>are</i> just before God, <u>but the doers of the law shall be justified.</u> The Just Shall Live By <u>His</u> Faith Hab 2:4 Behold, his soul <i>which</i> is lifted up is not upright in him: <u>but the just shall live by his faith.</u> Ezek 18:9 <u>Hath walked in my statutes, and hath kept my judgments, to deal truly; he is just,</u> he shall surely live, saith the Lord GOD. 1Kings 8:32 Then hear thou in heaven, and do, and judge thy servants, condemning the wicked, to bring his way upon his head; and <u>justifying the righteous, to give him according to his righteousness.</u> Rom 3:1-3 What advantage then hath the Jew? or what profit <i>is there</i> of circumcision? ² Much every way: chiefly, <u>because that unto them were committed the oracles of God.</u> ³ For what if some did not believe? <u>shall their unbelief make the faith of God without effect?</u>	Rom 10:1-13 Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that <u>they might be saved.</u> ² For I bear <u>them</u> record that <u>they</u> have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge. ³ For <u>they</u> being ignorant of <u>God's righteousness,</u> and going about to establish <u>their own righteousness,</u> have not submitted <u>themselves</u> unto the <u>righteousness of God.</u> ⁴ <u>For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.</u> ⁵ For Moses describeth the <u>righteousness which is of the law,</u> That <u>the man which doeth those things shall live by them.</u> ⁶ But the <u>righteousness which is of faith</u> speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down <i>from above</i>;) ⁷ Or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.) ⁸ But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, <i>even</i> in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, <u>the word of faith,</u> which we preach; ⁹ That <u>if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus,</u> and shalt <u>believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead,</u> <u>thou shalt be saved.</u> ¹⁰ For with the <u>heart man believeth unto righteousness;</u> and <u>with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.</u> ¹¹ For the scripture saith, Whosoever <u>believeth</u> on him shall not be ashamed. ¹² For there is no difference between the <u>Jew</u> and the <u>Greek:</u> for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. ¹³ For <u>whosoever</u> shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be <u>saved.</u>	Rom 3:21-22 But <u>now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested,</u> being witnessed by the law and the prophets; ²² Even the <u>righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ</u> unto all and upon <u>all them that believe:</u> for there is no difference: Acts 13:38-39 Be it known unto you therefore, men <i>and</i> brethren, <u>that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins:</u> ³⁹ And <u>by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.</u> The Just Shall Live By faith Gal 3:11-12 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, <i>it is evident:</i> for, <u>The just shall live by faith.</u> ¹² And <u>the law is not of faith:</u> but, <u>The man that doeth them shall live in them.</u> Rom 1:17 For therein is the <u>righteousness of God</u> revealed <u>from faith to faith:</u> as it is written, <u>The just shall live by faith.</u> Rom 3:26-28 To declare, <i>I say,</i> <u>at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.</u> ²⁷ Where <i>is</i> boasting then? <u>It is excluded.</u> <u>By what law? of works? Nay: but by the law of faith.</u> ²⁸ Therefore we conclude that a man is <u>justified by faith without the deeds of the law.</u>

Justify the Circumcision By Faith

30 which shall justify the circumcision by faith,

Luke 7:29-30 And all the people that heard him, and the publicans, justified God, being baptized with the baptism of John. ³⁰ But the Pharisees and lawyers rejected the counsel of God against themselves, being not baptized of him.

Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Acts 2:36-38 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. ³⁷ Now when they heard *this*, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men *and* brethren, what shall we do? ³⁸ Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Rom 3:29 *Is he* the God of the **Jews** only? *is he* not also of the **Gentiles**? Yes, of the **Gentiles** also: **30** Seeing *it* is one God,...

Justify the Uncircumcision Through Faith

...and uncircumcision through faith.

Gal 1:11-12 But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man. ¹² For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ. **15-16** But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called *me* by his grace, ¹⁶ To reveal his Son in me, that I might preach him among the **heathen**; immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood:

Rom 16:25-26 Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began, ²⁶ But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of faith:

Eph 2:5 Even when **we** were dead in sins, hath quickened **us** together with Christ, (by grace **ye** are saved;) **2:8-9** For by grace are **ye** saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: ⁹ Not of works, lest any man should boast.
