Man's Method of Obtaining the Righteousness of God Believing God and Obedience

(Pre-law Commandments)

Abel – Heb 11:4 <u>By faith</u> Abel <u>offered</u> unto God <u>a more excellent sacrifice than Cain</u>, <u>by which he obtained witness that he was righteous</u>, God testifying of his gifts:

Job – Job 1:1, 8, 2:3 ...that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil

Noah – Gen 6:9 Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God. Heb 11:7 By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the

world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.

Abel is the first recorded to live 'by faith'. After the flood, Noah became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.

(Law)

Israel – Deut 6:24-25 ²⁴ And the LORD commanded us to do all these <u>statutes</u>, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that he might preserve us alive, as *it is* at this day. ²⁵ And <u>it shall be our righteousness</u>, <u>if we observe to do all these commandments</u> before the LORD our God, <u>as he hath commanded us</u>.

Zacharias & Elisabeth – Luke 1:6 And they were <u>both righteous before God</u>, <u>walking in all the commandments and ordinances of</u> the Lord blameless.

Paul – Phil 3:6, 9 touching the <u>righteousness</u> which is in the law, blameless. 9 not having <u>mine own righteousness</u>, which is of the law
