
## Did Old Testament Saints Look Forward to the Cross for Salvation?

1 Peter 1:10-11 Of which salvation the prophets have inquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you: Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.

1 Corinthians 2:7-8 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: 8 Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

Luke 24:44-46 And he said unto them, These *are* the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and *in* the prophets, and *in* the psalms, concerning me. 45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures, 46 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day:



(No O.T. Saint was saved... if thou shalt confess w/thy mouth the Lord Jesus & shalt believe in thine heart that God will raise Him from the dead; Rom 10)

Luke 18:31-34 Then he took *unto him* the twelve, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and <u>all</u> things that are written by the prophets concerning the <u>Son of man shall be accomplished</u>. 32 For <u>he shall be delivered unto the Gentiles</u>, and <u>shall be mocked</u>, and <u>spitefully entreated</u>, and <u>spitted on</u>: 33 And <u>they shall scourge him</u>, and <u>put him to death</u>: and <u>the third day he shall rise again</u>. 34 And <u>they understood none of these things</u>: and <u>this saying was hid from them</u>, neither knew they the things which were spoken.



John 20:8-9 Then went in also that other disciple, which came first to the sepulchre, and he saw, and believed. 9 For as yet they knew not the scripture, that he must rise again from the dead.

1 Corinthians 1:23 But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks

Romans 16:25 Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began,

1 Corinthians 15:1-4 Moreover, brethren, <u>I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you</u>, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; <u>By which also ye are saved</u>, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. <u>For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received</u>, <u>how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures</u>; And that <u>he was buried</u>, and that <u>he rose again the third day according to the scriptures</u>:
