<p><b>Galatians 1:11-12 (KJV)</b> But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man. <b>12</b> For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.</p>	<p><b>1 Corinthians 15:1-4 (KJV)</b> Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; <b>2</b> By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. <b>3</b> For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; <b>4</b> And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:</p>

<p><b>Galatians 1:15-17 (KJV)</b> But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me by his grace, <b>16</b> To reveal his Son in me, that I might preach him among the heathen; immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood: <b>17</b> Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but I went into Arabia, and returned again unto Damascus.</p>	<p><b>1 Corinthians 1:17-18 (KJV)</b> For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect. <b>18</b> For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.</p>

<p><b>Galatians 2:1-2 (KJV)</b> Then fourteen years after I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, and took Titus with me also. <b>2</b> And I went up by revelation, and communicated unto them that gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to them which were of reputation, lest by any means I should run, or had run, in vain.</p>	<p>Cf. Gal 2:1-4; 5:1-4; 11 Cf. Acts 21:20-21</p>

<p><b>Galatians 2:7 (KJV)</b> But contrariwise, when they saw that the gospel of the uncircumcision was committed unto me, as the gospel of the circumcision was unto Peter;</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• gospel of the uncircumcision</li> <li>• was committed unto me</li> <li>• as the gospel of the circumcision was unto Peter</li> </ul>	

John the Baptist Ministry To Israel	Disciples Pre-Cross & Apostles Post-Cross Ministries To Israel
<p><b>Matthew 3:1-3 (KJV)</b> In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea, <b>2</b> And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. <b>3</b> For this is he that was spoken of by the prophet Esaias, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• preaching in the wilderness of Judaea</li> <li>• Repent ye</li> <li>• for the kingdom of heaven is at hand</li> </ul> <p><b>5-6</b> Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan, <b>6</b> And were baptized of him in Jordan, confessing their sins.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• went out to him <u>Jerusalem</u></li> <li>• and <u>all Judaea</u></li> <li>• and <u>all the region round about Jordan</u></li> <li>• And were <b>baptized of him</b> in Jordan</li> <li>• confessing <u>their sins</u></li> </ul> <p><b>Mark 1:4-5 (KJV)</b> John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins. <b>5</b> And there went out unto him all the land of Judaea, and they of Jerusalem, and were all baptized of him in the river of Jordan, confessing their sins.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• preach the baptism of repentance</li> <li>• for the remission of sins</li> <li>• went out unto him all the <u>land of Judaea</u></li> <li>• and <u>they of Jerusalem</u></li> <li>• and were <u>all</u> <b>baptized of him</b> in the river of Jordan</li> <li>• confessing <u>their sins</u></li> </ul> <p><b>Luke 3:3 (KJV)</b> And he came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>all the country about Jordan</u></li> <li>• preaching the baptism of repentance</li> <li>• for the remission of sins</li> </ul>	<p><b>Mark 16:15-16 (KJV)</b> And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. <b>16</b> He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• preach the gospel to every creature</li> <li>• He that believeth and is baptized</li> <li>• shall be saved</li> <li>• but he that believeth not</li> <li>• shall be damned</li> </ul> <p><b>Acts 2:36-38 (KJV)</b> Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. <b>37</b> Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? <b>38</b> Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• let all the <u>house of Israel</u> know assuredly</li> <li>• Now when <u>they</u> heard this</li> <li>• <u>they</u> were pricked in their heart</li> <li>• and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles</li> <li>• Men and brethren <b>what shall we do?</b></li> <li>• Then Peter said unto <u>them</u></li> <li>• Repent, and be baptized</li> <li>• <u>every one of you</u></li> <li>• in the name of Jesus Christ</li> <li>• for the remission of sins</li> <li>• and <u>ye</u> shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost</li> </ul> <p><b>Acts 3:19-20 (KJV)</b> Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; <b>20</b> And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Repent <u>ye</u></li> <li>• he shall send Jesus Christ</li> <li>• which before was preached unto <u>you</u></li> </ul>
